## MCC 2018 Championships

The MCC 2018 Club (Open) and Class (Under 2000) Championship were held in May 2018. Alan Song won the Club Championship with a perfect 5-0 score. He also raised his rating to over 2200 as a result, thus achieving the US Chess National Master (NM) title. Congratulations Alan! Alex Yu, Augustin Garcia, and Mark Kaprielian tied for 2nd-4th with 3.0 points. Kelsey Liu won the Class (U2000) section with four wins and a forfeit win, another perfect score. She gained 115 rating points for her effort reaching an all-time high of 1866. Congratulations Kelsey! Stuart Hall finished second with 3.0 points and Matt Phelps was third with 2.5.
