News:

Club Scorebooks:

When we reopened the club in 2023 we introduced our own club scorepad for use by players. We are now introducing our own **spiral bound club scorebook**.

Features:

- Custom designed to provide taller than typical rows to write in
 - o Same as the score-pads
- Double-sided pages so you now have up to 90 moves
- Every ten moves underlined

- Two diagrams for key positions
- 100 pages as opposed to typical score books of only 50 pages

Even if you throw out your score sheets later at home after entering them into a site or program, you always have your own set of double sided sheets with you while you are playing.



The scorebooks are available only at the club. Price is \$10.

Byes: How to Request or Change them

Once you are entered in an event you can Request or alter you Bye requests.

Remember, Byes must be made on the site no later than **7:15 pm** on the night of play

- Log into NAChessHub
- Find the event that you need to adjust your Byes for
- Go to the Roster page
- Find your name and click on the link in the Byes column for your name.
 - o It will say either "Request" or have the round numbers that you have previously requested Byes for.
