News:

Monthly Event:

In July we will again be offering prizes for our monthly event. Even though offering prizes did not seem to increase attendance in April, we feel it was, and still is, worth offering prizes for our members occasionally when we can. Thanks to the generosity of our long time member and patron Walter Champion we are able to not only offer prizes again but to increase the prize fund for both sections. The prizes being offered are the same prizes we used to offer for our top two sections back from the days when we had an average of 84 players each month.

Registration is now open for the event. Up to two half point byes as usual are available in case you have to miss a round. Due to prizes being offered, last round half-point Byes must be committed to before the start of play for Round 2.

Prizes for our event are:

- Open : \$140 : \$100 : \$80
- U1700: \$100 : \$80 : \$40

- Prize fund: **\$540, 100% guaranteed** (not based on attendance)
 - Prizes will be paid by PayPal few days after event

- Remember to rejoin the **USCF** if you have expired
 - Do not leave it to the last minute as there have been multiple reports of **renewal issues** and needing several **days** to resolve them.

- Remember to **join the club before you enter the event** to get the member discount.
 - If you forget, you will only be offered the non-member entry fees.

About Standings and Projected Pairings:

You can follow along each week by looking at the standings and projected pairings on the NACHessHub site.

- Go to [NACHessHub.com](https://www.NACHessHub.com)
- Find the clubs event.
 - For example, The **June** event is named: **MCC - 2026-06**
- Click on the **Pairing** Button to see the standings and projected pairings for each section.

Generally the standings and projected pairings will be posted on the site at the end of the night; If not, check back later the next day.

Byes: How to Request or Change them:

Once you are entered in an event you can Request or alter you Bye requests. Remember, Byes must be made on the site no later than **7:15 pm** on the night of play

- Log into NACHessHub
- Find the event that you need to adjust your Byes for
- Go to the Roster page
- Find your name and click on the link in the Byes column for your name.
 - It will say either "Request" or have the round numbers that you have previously requested Byes for.
