Former World Chess Champion Boris Spassky will deliver a lecture and give a chess exhibition in Framingham, Massachusetts on Sunday, September 30. Spassky has been living in Paris since 1976 with the permission of the Soviet authorities, but severed his ties with the USSR in June of this year.
