## SUMMER SCHEDULE 1985

May 28; June 4, 11 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM JUNE QUADRANGULAR. 3-RR in 4-player sections (possible 3-SS in odd-numbered section). EF: FCC members, \$6; others \$8. Prizes: 1st \$15 in each section.

June 4 (Tuesday): UNRATED INTRODUCTORY TOURNAMENT. 3-SS. EF: FCC members, \$3; others \$4. Entry restricted to unrated or rated under 1200. USCF membership or plaque to 1st. TL: SD/30. Rounds at 8, 9, and 10PM; register before 7:45.

June 15-16 (Saturday-Sunday): 2ND ANNUAL WEST SUBURBAN SUMMER GRAND PRIX. 4-SS in four sections at the American Legion. A major regional tournament with \$1000 projected cash prizes and 10 Grand Prix points. See tournament flyer or Chess Horizons for details.

June 18 (Tuesday): MATERIAL-HANDICAP SPEED TOURNAMENT. Speed tournament (5-minute games) in which the higher-rated player gives material odds based on rating difference.

June 25; July 2, 9, 16 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM SUMMER SECTIONAL SWISS. 4-SS in two sections: Premier (1600 and over) and Reserve (under 1600). EF: FCC members \$7; others \$10. Prizes: 60% of Premier entries to 1st; 25% to 1st under 1800; in Reserve, 60% of Reserve entries to 1st, 25% to 1st under 1350.

July 2 (Tuesday): UNRATED INTRODUCTORY TOURNAMENT. See June 4 for details.

July 23, 30; August 6 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM SUMMER OCTAGONAL. 3-SS in 8-12 player sections. EF: FCC members \$6; others \$8. Prizes: 1st \$25, 2nd \$10 in each section.

July 30 (Tuesday): UNRATED INTRODUCTORY TOURNAMENT. See June 4 for details.

August 13 (Tuesday): 3RD ANNUAL FRAMINGHAM CHESS CLUB SPEED CHAMPIONSHIP. 5-minute games. RR format. EF: \$1. Open to all, but only FCC members eligible for finals. Reigning speed champion: Jack Young.

August 20, 27; September 3 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM SUMMER CLASS TOURNAMENT. 3-SS in USCF rating class sections. (Some class boundaries may be shifted at the TD's discretion to produce equitable sections.) EF: FCC members \$3; others \$5. Prizes: 85% of section entries to 1st in each section.

September 10, 13 (Tuesday, Friday): TEAM MATCH AGAINST THE BILLERICA CHESS CLUB. First round in Framingham on Tuesday, second round in Billerica on Friday.

Events are USCF-rated unless otherwise indicated. Time limits unless otherwise indicated are 40/90, 15/30, sudden death/30. Tournament rounds start at 7:30; registration closes at 7:20 before the first round. EF=entry fee. SS=Swiss system. RR=round robin. TL=time limit.
