- June 23 (Tuesday): JUNE TIME-HANDICAP SPEED TOURNAMENT. RR-format. 5-min games with time-handicap of 1 min/100 rating points. EF: \$2; all entries returned as prizes.
- June 30; July 7, 14, 21, 28 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM SUMMER SECTIONAL SWISS. 5-SS in Open and Under-1700 sections. EF: FCC members \$8; others \$12. 1st \$50, 2nd \$25, 3rd \$20 each section; 1st Under-1900/1500 \$15.
- August 4, 11, 18 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM SUMMER CLASS TOURNAMENT. 3-SS in Master/Expert, Class A, B, C, D/E sections. (Classes may be combined should there be fewer than four players in a section. TD will assign unrateds to appropriate section.) EF: FCC members \$6; others \$9. 85% of entries returned as prizes each section.
- August 16 (Sunday): CIVILIZED SWISS #3. 3-SS in 8-12 player sections. EF: FCC members \$10 advance/\$12 at site; others \$12/\$15. 1st-2nd \$40-\$25 each section. Reg. by 9:30 a.m.
- August 16 (Sunday): UNRATED INTRODUCTORY TOURNAMENT. 3-SS; TL 60/SD. EF: FCC members \$3; others \$5. Trophy or USCF memb. to 1st. Entry restricted to under-1200 or unrated.
- August 25 (Tuesday): FRAMINGHAM CHESS CLUB SPEED CHAMPIONSHIP. 5-min games; RR-format. Open, but only club members eligible for championship. EF: \$3; trophy/title to 1st.
- September 1, 8, 15, 22 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM SEPTEMBER SECTIONAL SWISS. 4-SS in Open and Under-1600 section. EF: FCC members \$8; others \$12. 55% and 30% of section entries to 1st-2nd each section.
- September 1, 8, 15, 22; October 13, 20, 27 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM CHALLENGE CUP. Invitational round-robin featuring the club's leading players.
- September 19-20 (Saturday-Sunday): 4TH FRAMINGHAM OPEN. 4-SS in four sections. A major regional Grand-Prix level tournament at the club with \$1000 projected class prizes. See tournament flyer or Chess Life or Chess Horizons.
- September 29; October 6 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM CHESS CLUB 30/30 CHAMPIONSHIP. 4-SS in rated and unrated sections. TL: 30/30, 30/SD. Rounds at 7:30 and 9:30 each night. EF: FCC members \$6; others \$9. Prizes: 55% and 30% of section entries to 1st-2nd each section. Championship title and trophy to top club member in rated section.
- October 13, 20, 27 (Tuesdays): FRAMINGHAM OCTOBER OCTAGONAL. 3-SS in 8-12 player sections. EF: FCC members \$8; others \$12. 1st-2nd \$30-\$20 each section.
- November 1 (Sunday): CIVILIZED SWISS #4. 3-SS in 8-12 player sections. EF: FCC members \$10 advance/\$12 at site; others \$12/\$15. 1st-2nd \$40-\$25 each section. Reg. by 9:30 a.m.
