*A one-day Saturday Swiss in Framingham.*

DATE: May 19, 1984

SITE: The American Legion hall, 11 Beech Street, Framingham. From Framingham Centre, turn south onto Union Street, and right after two blocks onto Franklin Street. Proceed 1 1/4 miles south to the Legion, which is on the corner of Franklin and Beech Streets.

FORMAT: Four-round single section Swiss system tournament. The time limit will be 40 moves per hour. Rounds at 10AM, 12:45PM, 3:30PM, and 6:15PM.

PRIZES: 1st, \$65; 2nd, \$35; 3rd, \$25; based on 25 entries. Prize fund may be increased if more entries.

ENTRY FEE: \$12 if recieved by 5/18; \$15 at the door.

MEMBERSHIPS: All players must be current members of the US Chess Federation (\$20 adult, \$3 if under 18, available at the door) or pay a surcharge of \$1 per game.

SMOKING: There will be no smoking in the playing area. You may smoke outside the tournament room.
