News:

Rumors:

There are rumors that both MACA and the MCC will be moving to the Future Masters Chess Academy new location in Ashland.

While it is true that MACA will probably start holding events there, there are **no plans or intentions to move the club** to that location.

Since there will be less weeks we've reduced the entry Fee by \$8 dollars for both members and Non-Members

Steps:

- 1. Create an Account:
 - a. Click on "Sign up" link. Create Username and Password.
 - b. You will receive a confirmation email; follow the steps from there to complete your own profile. (Check Junk folder if do not see email in your Inbox.)
 - c. Include your credit card under Billing; and sign the Waiver form.
- 2. Purchase the Tournament:
 - a. Go to Store; under All Items choose Tournaments. Find desired tournament to register. You can also see tournament details listed.
 - b. Click on Add to cart and then checkout.

Click on Complete Payment. You should receive an email receipt.

The **MCC** home page has links to all the things you need to know to start playing at the club. Please read the materials on the home page carefully.

- Remember to rejoin the **USCF** if you have expired
 - Do not leave it to the last minute as there have been multiple reports of renewal issues and needing several days to resolve them.
- Remember to join the club before you enter the event to get the member discount.
 - o If you forget, you will only be offered the non-member entry fees.

Standings and Projected Pairings:

You can follow along each week by looking at the standings and projected pairings on the NAChessHub site.

- Go to NAChessHub.com
- Find the clubs event.
 - o For example, The **January** event is named: **MCC 2024-01**
- Click on the **Pairing** Button to see the standings and projected pairings for each section.

Generally the standings and projected pairings will be posted on the site at the end of the night; If not, check back later the next day.

Byes: How to Request or Change them

Once you are entered in an event you can Request or alter you Bye requests.

Remember, Byes must be made on the site no later than **7:15 pm** on the night of play

- Log into NAChessHub
- Find the event that you need to adjust your Byes for
- Go to the Roster page
- Find your name and click on the link in the Byes column for your name.
 - It will say either "Request" or have the round numbers that you have previously requested Byes for.


