MIKHAIL TAL

LECTURE AND SIMULTANEOUS EXHIBITION

TUESDAY, MARCH 8

International Grandmaster Mikhail Tal will appear at the Framingham Chess Club on Tuesday, March 8, with a lecture at 7 p.m. on his games with Bobby Fischer, to be followed by a brief question and answer period, and a 30-board simultaneous exhibition at 8 p.m. Tal's bold play is famous for an attacking elan equalled perhaps only by Alekhine. World Champion 1960-1961 (the youngest title-holder to that time), Tal has scored nearly 50 first-place finishes in major international tournaments, including a record-tying six Soviet championships. Tal is one of the ten highest-rated players of all time, and demonstrated once again his superstar form last month in New Brunswick, where he decisively won the World Blitz Championship. Tal joins Boris Spassky, Sammy Reshevsky, Roman Dzindzichashvili, Zsuzsa Polgar, and Nigel Short on the roster of superstars appearing in the last four years at the Framingham Chess Club.

ADMISSION

DIRECTIONS

From the Mass Pike (I-90), take exit 13 and branch right after the toll booths. Continue one mile to merge with Route 9 westbound. From Route 9 westbound, take Route 30/Southboro/Trolley Square exit and turn left at the lights onto Union Street. From Route 9 eastbound, take Framingham Centre/Edgell Road exit and turn right at the lights onto Union Street. From Union Street, continue two blocks and turn right onto Franklin Street. Proceed $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles down Franklin Street to the American Legion at the corner of Franklin and Beech Streets. The Framingham Chess Club meets in the brick wing attached to the Legion.
